

## Top sport meets top technology

### Sportschule FFB-Puch offers athletes protection through UV-C air purification from Dr. Höhle AG



After months of absence, the athletes were finally allowed to return to the hallowed halls last June: The sports school FFB-Puch opened its equipment park and the training rooms after the long coronavirus lockdown for high-performance athletes, amateur athletes, seniors and children who regularly use the excellent training facilities on site. The sports school not only attracts sports enthusiasts from the area, but is also a well-known training facility for top athletes from all over Bavaria and beyond.

The expectations of a sports experience in Puch are therefore correspondingly high. In addition to high-quality equipment, the know-how of the team, drawing on 30 years of experience, and a family atmosphere, managing director Lenz Westner also wants to offer his sports students the highest hygiene and safety standards. "Coronavirus will probably be with us for a while yet, and there will certainly be new viruses in the future," says Westner. In order not to make its range of sports vulnerable to pandemic waves in the future, Westner has invested in several UV-C air disinfection devices from Dr. Höhle AG. "We have up to 700 visitors a day and I am also responsible for 45 employees - it is our top priority to protect everyone's health," he adds. The disinfection devices were therefore installed in the changing rooms as well as in the smaller training rooms and in the stairwell. They are an important component of a comprehensive hygiene concept at the sports school.

The FFB-Puch sports school also attaches great importance to sustainability. With more than 12,000 hours of operation for the fluorescent tubes, Höhle's air sterilizers require extremely low maintenance. Due to the energy-saving systems, the devices only require a low power level. "After extensive research into the range on the air purifier market, the Höhle devices convinced me the most," says Westner. As a trained electrical engineer, he was surprised at how uncomplicated the installation of the air sterilizer was. "Even someone with two left hands could install the devices."

But Westner is not only very satisfied with the devices themselves: "The experts at Dr. Höhle AG supported me with advice and assistance throughout the entire process of planning, selecting and installing the equipment - this enabled me to create a safe training environment and meet our claim of always offering the best for our sports students." Together with his team, Lenz Westner is looking forward to a sporty year and, thanks to his sustainable hygiene concept, is also optimistic about the long term future.
